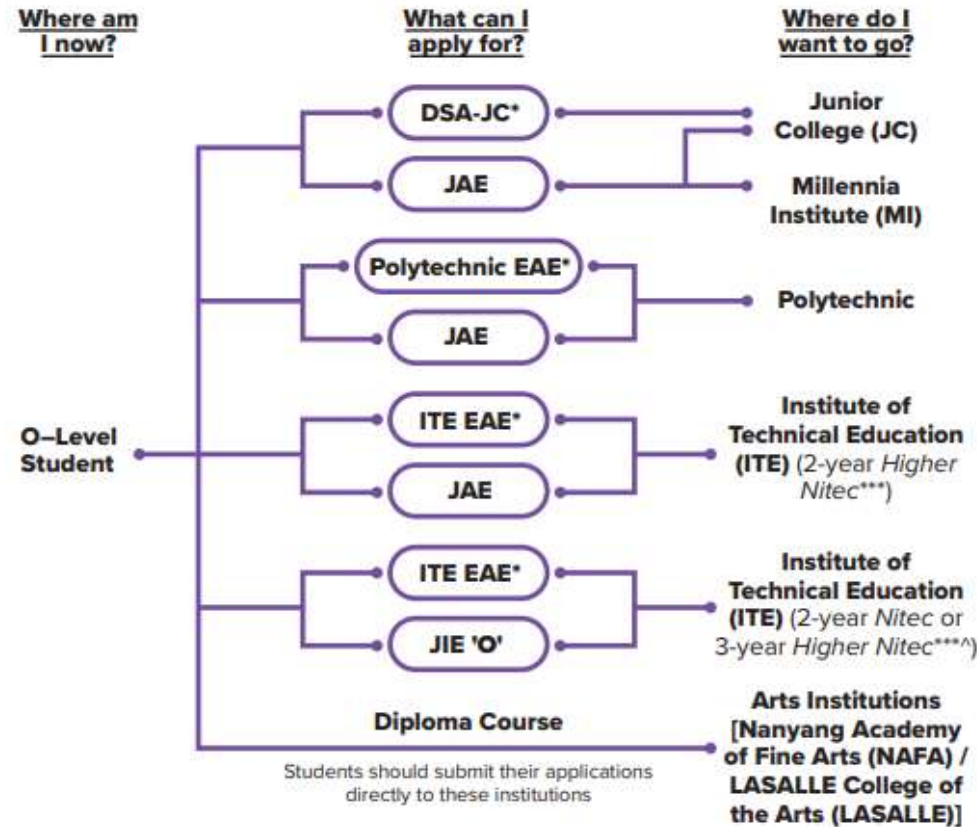

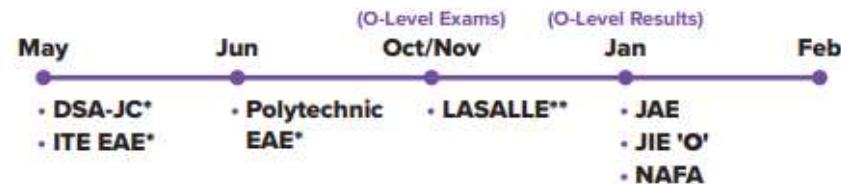

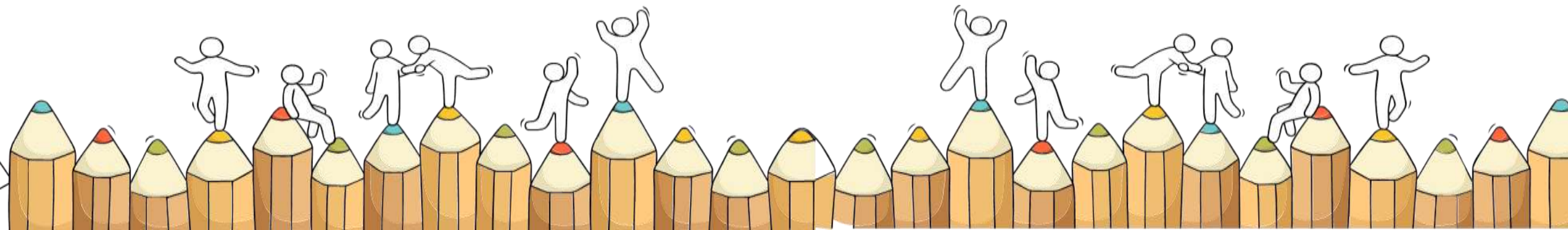

- Registration must be done **online through JAE-IS** (Link available in Form A)
- Use the JAE Worksheet to assist you in your registration. Make full use of the **12 choices, listed in order of preference.**
- Print and **retain a copy of the Verification Slip** for your record upon submission

Posting results are scheduled for release on **2 Feb 2023** through the following modes:

# Direct School Admissions (DSA) / Early Admissions Exercise (EAE)



- Students successfully admitted to institutions through DSA-JC / Poly-EAE will not be able to participate in the JAE. **Form A will show that you have been admitted to an institution through DSA-JC or EAE.**
- Unsuccessful DSA-JC/Poly-EAE applicants can participate in the JAE.

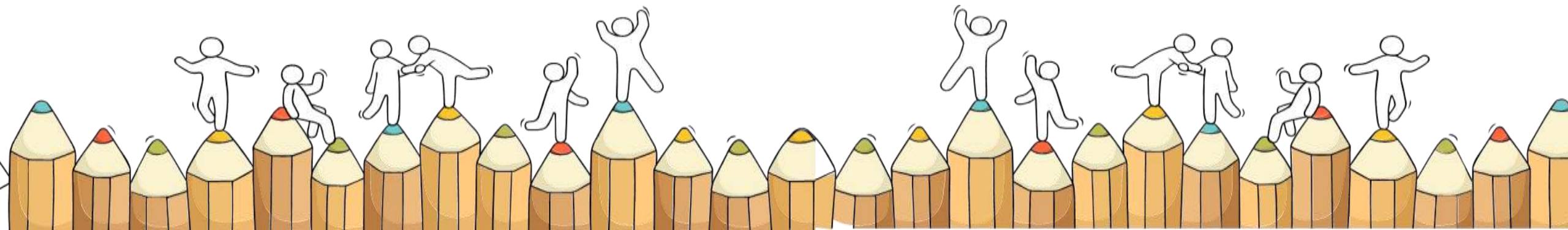
# JAE Application Reminders



- In the application portal, update/check that your
  - **home & mobile phone numbers,**
  - and **email address** is correct.
- Placement is based on **merit** and **vacancy** available.
- Note that aggregate scores found in the JAE booklet are meant as a **reference** and **do not** constitute the admission points for subsequent admission exercises.
- Utilise all **12 choices**.
  - Top few choices: You may wish to select course you are passionate about and for which your aggregate score is **less than/equal to/not too far above** the previous year's score.
  - Following choices: To maximize the likelihood of being posted to a course of your choice, you should ensure that for some of your selected course, your aggregate score is **less than** the previous year's score.
  - It is important to **rank** the courses in the order of your preference.

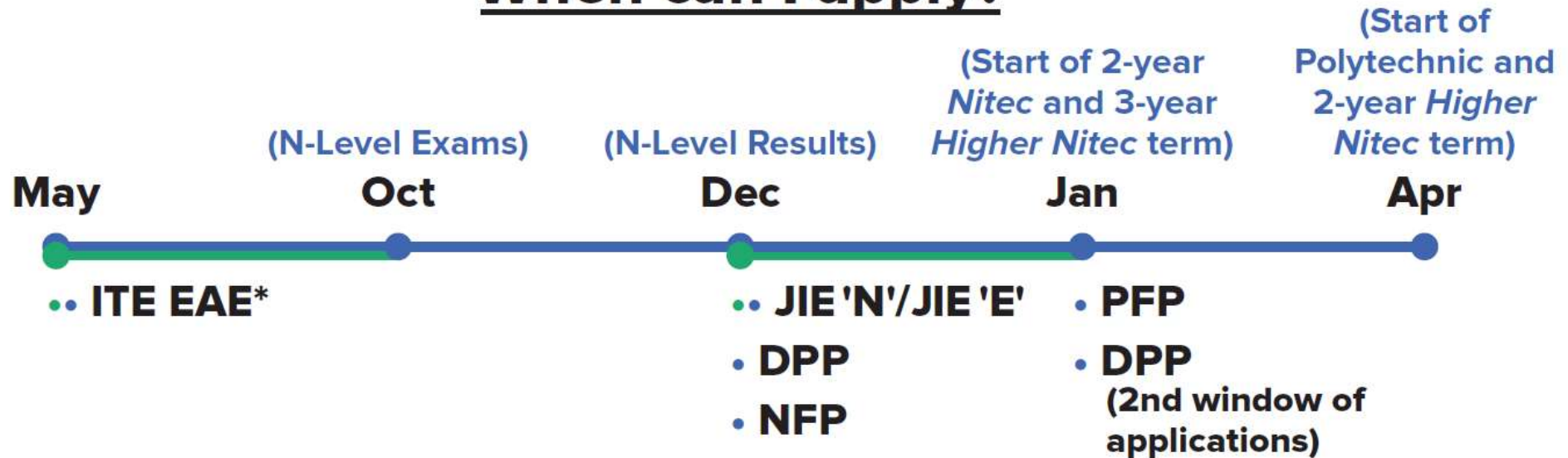

# Form P



Eligible students will receive **Form P**, inviting you to apply for Polytechnic Foundation Programme.

Registration Period	Start	End
	12 Jan 2023 2.00pm	17 Jan 2023 4.00pm

- Form P consists of a **unique password**.
- Submit application **online** via PFP website:

# PFP Application



- PFP Posting Results will be released at **2.00pm on 26 Jan 2023** through the PFP website.
- Applicants are required to indicate whether they wish to **accept, reject, or appeal** for a change of course by **4.00pm on 31 Jan 2023**

## Can I appeal for the course offered to me?

- You may submit an appeal upon the release of the posting results.
- If your appeal is **successful**, you may choose to accept or reject the offer. Note that your **original offer will be voided**, regardless of whether you accept the new offer.
- If your appeal is **unsuccessful**, you have the option of **accepting or rejecting your original offer**.



# Final Application Phase of DPP



- Secondary 4N(A) students who are **newly eligible after considering your O-Level exam results** should submit your DPP applications online via the DPP application portal at [www.ite.edu.sg/apply-for-ite-courses](http://www.ite.edu.sg/apply-for-ite-courses)

Registration Period	Start	End
	12 Jan 2023	17 Jan 2023

- Posting Results will be released at **9.00am on 19 Jan 2023** through the DPP application portal.
- Students are required to indicate whether they wish to accept or reject the DPP offer by **25 Jan 2023**.

# FAQ for PFP & DPP



Can I apply for both PFP & DPP?

- Yes. Students who have accepted a place in the earlier application phase of the DPP in December but decide to take up a PFP offer now must withdraw from the DPP first before they are able to take up the PFP offer. DPP-enrolled students should check with their ITE class advisor for more details on the DPP withdrawal process and deadlines for withdrawal.

## **For successful PFP and/or DPP applicants**

- Students who have been offered a place in the DPP under the final application phase should report to ITE on Wednesday, 25 January 2023 upon acceptance of their DPP course offer.
- The last day of school for Secondary 5 students who have accepted a place in the PFP will be on Friday, 27 January 2023. Students will be informed by the respective polytechnics on the enrolment dates for the PFP.

# Details of Admission Exercises



## DPP – Direct-Entry-Scheme to Polytechnic Programme

DPP allows Secondary 4N(A) students to be admitted directly into a two-year *Higher Nitec* programme at ITE without having to sit for the O-Level examinations or undergo a *Nitec* programme.

DPP students who successfully complete their *Higher Nitec* courses at ITE and attain the required qualifying Grade Point Average (GPA) scores are guaranteed a place in a polytechnic diploma course mapped to their *Higher Nitec* course.

## NFP – NAFA Foundation Programme

The NFP is a full-time one-year practice-based programme targeted at N(A) students, to prepare them for the successful enrolment and completion of a diploma programme at NAFA. Students enrolled into the NFP are offered provisional places in their pre-selected diploma courses, and can progress to the first year of the course upon the successful completion of the NFP.

## PFP – Polytechnic Foundation Programme

PFP is a one-year programme that offers a practice-oriented curriculum taught by polytechnic lecturers to better prepare polytechnic-bound N(A) students for entry into selected polytechnic diploma courses. PFP students are given provisional places in diploma programmes, subject to them passing all modules in the 1-year PFP.

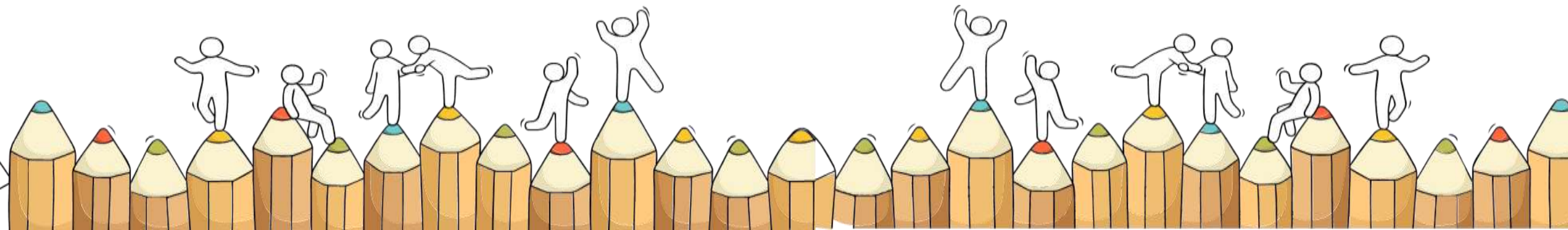
