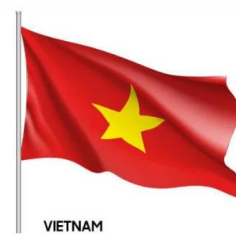

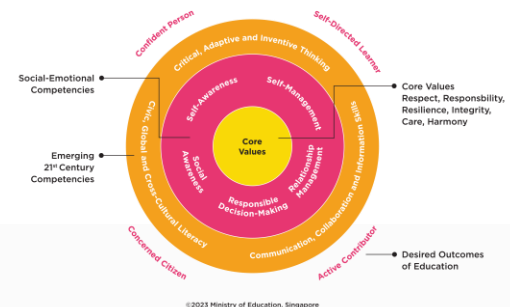

Objectives

Ensure that the passport expiry date is more than half a year on date of arrival back to Singapore.

Safety Considerations

- Programming / Choice of location
 - Recce by a team of SL and HODs
- Preparation of students
 - SOPs / Briefing
- Manpower
 - Ratio of 1 adult : 10 students
 - School Leader, Key Personnel, FTs
- Emergency Services
 - ISOS

Estimated trip Cost: \$1000 (actual cost might defer slightly)
(does not include VISA application fee)

School subsidy for **all** students : 10% of cost

MOE subsidy for **all Singaporean** students
(including school subsidy) : 50% of cost

MOE FAS and School based FAS students will enjoy **further** subsidies.
